## 1. Overview

Kilrush Credit Union's Student Bursary has been established to support local students as they take the next step in their education or training.

The bursary award is €1,000 and is subject to the terms and conditions outlined below.

The bursary is awarded in memory of Mick Tevlin, in recognition of his commitment to education and the local community.

## 2. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to apply for and receive the Student Bursary, applicants must:

- Be a **current member of Kilrush Credit Union** (or become a member prior to the award being issued).
- Hold the bursary in **their own Credit Union account**. Parent or guardian accounts may not be used.
- Be a registered student of either:
  - **Kilrush Community School**, or
  - **Kilkee Community College**.
- One student per school will receive a €1000 bursary
- Be progressing to one of the following:
  - **Third-level education** (college or university),
  - **Further education**, including a recognised PLC course, or
  - A registered **apprenticeship programme**.

The bursary is **not awarded based on academic performance or exam results**.

Proof of enrolment or acceptance into the relevant course or apprenticeship must be provided before the bursary is paid.

## 3. Application Conditions

- Only **one application per student** is permitted.
- Applications must be completed in full and submitted before the stated closing date.
- Incomplete or late applications may not be considered.
- Applicants may be asked to provide additional documentation or clarification to support their application.

## 4. Selection Process

- All eligible applications received by the closing date will be entered into a random draw.
- One winner will be selected per secondary school within the Kilrush Credit Union common bond.

- The draw will be conducted under the supervision of 2 staff members.
- The outcome of the draw is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

## 5. Award Conditions

- The bursary will be paid into the student's own Kilrush Credit Union account upon confirmation of enrolment in an eligible course or apprenticeship.
- The award is non-transferable and cannot be deferred to another academic year without prior approval.
- Kilrush Credit Union reserves the right to withhold or withdraw the bursary if eligibility criteria are not met or if false or misleading information is provided.

## 6. General

Kilrush Credit Union reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions where necessary. Any updates will be communicated clearly.

Kilrush Credit Union reserves the right to cancel or amend the bursary if circumstances beyond its control arise.

Winners may be asked to participate in a short promotional activity or photograph. Applicants consent to the use of their name and photograph for promotional purposes if they are awarded the bursary.

By submitting an application, applicants confirm that the information provided is accurate and that they agree to these Terms and Conditions.
